CHARITY COMMISSION

In the matter of the Charity known as The Alfred Palmer Memorial Playing Field, in the Parishes of Stratfield Mortimer and Wokefield, in the Royal County of Berkshire, regulated by conveyance and trust deed dated the 15th June 1939, as varied or affected by a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners of the 6th December 1989; and

In the matter of the Charities Act 1960.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HEREBY ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established:-

SCHEME

- 1. Subject to such consents as are required by law the Trustees of the abovementioned Charity may sell the land specified in the schedule hereto and belonging to the Charity and may do and execute all proper acts and assurances for carrying the sale into effect.
- 2. Unless the Commissioners otherwise direct the clear proceeds of such sale as aforesaid shall be invested in trust for the Charity.
- 3. The Trustees shall apply the clear income arising from the investments from time to time representing the said proceeds of sale for the upkeep, maintenance and improvement of the recreation field belonging to the Charity.

SCHEDULE



Land containing .25 of an acre or thereabouts situate in the Parish of Stratfield Mortimer, in the Royal County of Berkshire being the land with the building thereon known as the Scout Hut being part of the land comprised in the above-mentioned conveyance and trust deed dated the 15th June 1939 and made between Henry Arthur Benyon of the first part Gerald Eustace Howell Palmer and four others of the second part and Neil William Gardiner and two others of the third part and recorded in the books of the Charity Commissioners on the 20th September 1939 pursuant to section 29(4) of the Settled Land Act 1925.

Note. The above-mentioned land is vested in the Official Custodian for Charities by virtue of an Order of the Charity Commissioners of the 5th March 1940 as affected by the provisions of the Charities Act 1960.
